

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ROADSIDE VENDORS

Defination: Any person, or group, of persons who sell products or services on the right-of-way, which does not adjoin their own property.

Excluded are:


- 1) Mobile Canteens
- 2) Wreckers and Emergency Services.
- 3) Non-profit Organizations with permission of landowners.


1) Permits: All roadside vendors must obtain a permit from the Town of Fryeburg for which there will be a ^{5.00} fee. The applicant must have written permission from the abutting landowner, when applying for the permit. The Selectmen have the right to accept or reject any applicant.


2) Town-owned Properties: Use of these lands is limited in use by Vendors to:

- a) Special events: Sponsored by civic and/or non-profit organizations.
- b) Contracted Vendors: Contracted with by the Town of Fryeburg for specific functions.
- c) Other Vendors: Other vendors which the Selectmen deem beneficial to the inhabitants of the Town of Fryeburg.

3) Penalties: Every person or group of persons convicted of a violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Ten (10) dollars, or more than One hundred (100.) dollars. All fines recovered shall be to the use and benefit of the inhabitants of the Town of Fryeburg.
