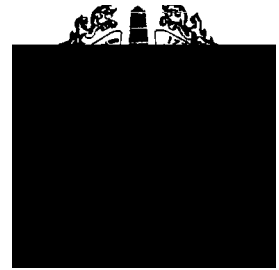

April 15, 2010

- 1. Meeting called to order and declared a quorum.**
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance**
- 3. Motion to go into Executive Session made by Cliff, seconded by Ed.
Vote: 3-0 in favor.**
- 4. Motion by Cliff to come out of out Executive Session; seconded by Ed Vote:
3-0 in favor**
- 5. Motion made to adopt Resolution Pursuant to 30-A M.R.S.A. section 2633
made by Ed Wilkey, seconded by Cliff. Vote: 2-1 in favor.**
- 6. New Business:**

**Motion made by Ed Wilkey to approve Liquor License renewal for Fryeburg
House of Pizza, Seconded by Tom. Vote: 3-0 in favor.**

- 7. Motion made by Tom to allow use of Weston's Beach for one hour on May
16, 2010, by Shelby Stevenson. Seconded by Ed. Vote 3-0 in favor.**
- 7. Manager's Report was read.**
- 8. Public Forum:**
 - Ken Brown asked, "What can you share with us in reference to the Executive
Session that was held?**
 - Cliff: It is a public document and shows reasons for dismissal.**
 - Judy – Who granted the Canal Bridge parking lot to be grated?**
 - Sharon – I don't know.**
 - Cliff – Probably Gary.**
 - Ken Brown – Aren't the gates supposed to be locked?**
 - Judy – Sign still says campground still open.**

**Lawrence Perry – (showing pamphlets) Does the 18 thousand covers the cost for the Police Department to send officers down there?
This is a Federal Water Way why is the town taking care of it?**

Discussion ensued about the canal bridge being Town or Federal responsibility.

Cliff – Closing Public Forum

9. Other Business:

Cliff – I have a question about the Town acting as a front for Fryeburg Business Association. Who are the officers? How are they voted in?

Is it a not for profit association or a non profit association:

Tom: The Fryeburg Business Association is working together to improve the down town area and to hire a professional to do it. That is what next weeks meeting is about.

Cliff: Big objective is to get a \$600,000.00 grant to refurbish down town. I want the people to know that I am not endorsing a not for profit association. I have a lot of questions.

Sharon: Explaining the grant: The money is wired to the Town of Fryeburg, if grant is approved. They fund municipalities; any organizations may apply for funds. They apply to the Town propose a plan. Then the Town has to vote to accept the funds. A certified Grant Administrator (Sharon is one) has to oversee the project, they advertise for grant planners. When the bills start to come in the Fryeburg Business Association turns them over to the Town the town then reviews the bill, once authorized the town sends a check to the Fryeburg Business Association and they in turn pay the company that the monies are owed to. Discussion continued.
