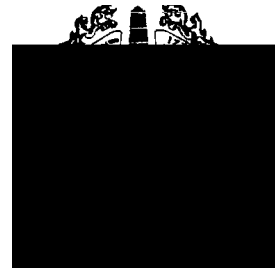

Selectmen's Meeting  
April 22, 2010

1. Meeting called to order and declared a quorum.
2. Pledge of Allegiance
3. Motion made to go into Public Hearing for Community Development Planning Grant made by Cliff, seconded by Tom. Vote: 2-0 in favor.
4. PUBLIC HEARING HELD.
5. Motion made by Cliff to come out of Public Hearing and resume Selectmen's meeting. seconded by Tom. Vote: 2-0 in favor
6. NEW BUSINESS:
  - A. Motion made by Tom to approve minutes of April 15, 2010; seconded by Cliff. Vote: 2-0 in favor.
  - B. Review and approve the Accounts Payable Warrant #50, pay period 21, to be signed once meeting is closed.
  - C. Review and approve Payroll Warrant #50, pay period 21 to be signed once meeting is closed.
  - D. Financial Report: Tom stated that a lot of people are coming in to pay their taxes.
  - E. Manager's Report: Last Budget meeting is Monday, April 26, 2010 7:00 PM until 9:00 PM. The Town Report will be ready and printed by May 7, 2010. Final date on taxes is May 18, 2010, before interest accrues.
  - F. Discussion on compliance of zoning ordinance not held.
  - G. Presentation of Fryeburg Business Association held: Fryeburg Business Association is a non-profit association, Donna Woodward, President. Membership is open to any business owner or any representative of a business, retirees are also welcome. Membership is \$35.00. Fryeburg Business Association is totally volunteer. They must meet at least four times a year, and members must be present to vote. May 11, 2010 is the

next meeting. On June 8<sup>th</sup> the guest speaker possibly could be Congressman Michaud.

- H. Discussion and update on Canal Bridge Campground held: Sharon, Cliff, Dennis McIver, Bill Perry, Fryeburg Code Enforcement Officer, Katie, all met at the campground today to discuss safety issues with the campground. Dennis McIver to do a proposal by Wednesday, April 28, 2010 so that it may be reviewed with Bill Perry and be presented to the Selectman on Thursday night. The goal is to take care of safety issues first, then to identify how they may proceed in phases, with the approval of the State so that the expenditures may be spread out over time.  
Bill Mosher - Is the campground still under the same management?  
Cliff – a lease is in effect, not void.
- I. Discussion and update on Haley Town Road held: Burr Phillips, Civil Solutions, met with the DEP and he is going to submit a plan. Glen Builders has asked that their retainer be released, this is not recommended.  
Cliff read a letter sent by David Hastings to David Cole asking him to reconsider the removal of the Red Iron Bridge and that Mr. Cole come to Fryeburg to see the bridge.

#### 7. PUBLIC FORUM:

Ken Brown: Is there a missing 9 mm pistol? I have heard its been used for fire practice.

Cliff: There has been a report of a missing firearm the Police Chief is investigating this.

Ken Brown: Is there only one weapon missing?

Cliff: That is correct.

Ken Brown: Town reports do not need to be delivered by the Police Department, why waste town money?

Cliff: This would be for shut-ins. The thought is that when a Police Officer who is on duty and is on patrol in an area where there is a request for the Town Report, the officer will drop it off. They will not make a special trip to deliver the Town Report. It is only when they are in the area.

Tom: This is good PR for the Police and the Town.

Rick Eastman: I just want to say that Sharon brings a positive attitude to the meetings. Thank you.

Cliff: Motion to adjourn, seconded by Tom. Vote: 2-0 in favor.
