

LIBRARY POLICY FOR EVENT POSTINGS AND POLITICAL SIGNAGE

The Fryeburg Public Library's Community Bulletin Board is for the posting of events for Fryeburg non-profit organizations. Any community events for other towns may be approved for posting as space is available or displayed on the interior side of the main front door, where we do allow other community events to be publicized. All event postings are at the discretion of the Librarian.

All political posters, signage, brochures and pamphlets for political campaigns, events or elections of any kind, at any time, will also be posted or made available to the public at the discretion of the librarian. Political information, as outlined above and approved, will be displayed on a table in the library lobby or on the interior side of the main front door, for a limited period of time during "Library Open Hours" prior to any election or political event.

No advertising for any private or for-profit businesses will be allowed.
