

Fryeburg Public Library Covid Response Services

(phases are subject to change based on local, state, and national data. Phases may be moved forward or backward)



Phase 2

- Building closed to the public
- No in-person services
- Curbside pickup only
- No inter-library loans
- Book drop open
- Virtual programs

Phase 3

- Building closed to the public
- Curbside pickup
- Inter-library loan Services
- Both virtual and outdoor programming

Phase 4

- Building open for limited days and hours. Limit visit to 15 minutes or less.
- Children's area browsing for 15 minutes or less, toys removed.
- Public computers available for 15 minutes or less
- Mask and social distancing are required for patrons 2 and up children under 12 must be accompanied by adult

Phase 5

- Building open back to full hours of operation
- Only 3-5 patron in the library at a time
- Children's area will be open for browsing, toys removed
- Curbside service by request
- 30 minute per visit limit
- Computer and printer use for essential functions
- Masks and social distancing are required for patrons ages 2 and up.

Phase 6

- Full building open for normal hours of operation
- No time limits on visits
- Normal programming
- Meeting space open to outside groups
- Curbside service is no longer an option
- Social distancing restrictions no longer in place
