

Fryeburg Airport Solar

Project Factsheet

4.99 MW – 20 Acres

- Location:
 - Eastern Slope Regional Airport, Between Porter Road and Route 113.
 - The site is **adjacent** to CMP's **existing distribution system**.
 - Vegetative **buffer** prevents any visual impact to residential areas.
- Benefits to taxpayers and ratepayers:
 - Generates power for approximately 725 homes.
 - Significant increase in property tax revenue to Fryeburg.
 - Will **save Maine ratepayers money** as confirmed by the Public Utility Commission.
 - The project uses **no taxpayer or ratepayer dollars**; it is fully funded by Dirigo Solar.
- Good for Fryeburg's Economy—More Jobs:
 - **70 construction jobs**.
 - **5 long-term jobs** associated with the maintenance of the facility.
 - **Local businesses to benefit**.
 - Opportunity to **co-locate agricultural activities** at the solar farm, including **sheep grazing** and/or **beekeeping**.
- Dirigo Solar's Track Record Working with Maine Towns:
 - Projects in **Oxford, Fairfield, Milo, and Augusta** currently **under construction**.
 - Projects in **Winslow, Auburn, Poland** scheduled for construction in 2021.
