TRANSFER STATION STICKER & USE POLICY

The Fryeburg Transfer Station is for use by Fryeburg property owners and residents. No vehicle will be allowed entry to the Transfer Station without a current Transfer Station window sticker. Stickers are valid from September 1st to August 31st. A grace period may be provided for vehicles with a valid sticker from the prior year, which may be allowed entry during the month of September only. As of October 1, all vehicles without a valid sticker will not be allowed to utilize the facility and will be turned away and made to leave if found within the facility.

Stickers may be purchased at the Town Office or Transfer Station, during normal business hours. The following criteria must be met:

- 1. A current vehicle registration of the vehicle on which the sticker will go shall be presented at the time of sticker issuance. To qualify for a sticker, applicants may be asked to provide proof of current residence in Fryeburg.
- 2. Residents who have company-owned vehicles not registered in Fryeburg may receive a residential sticker upon presenting a current vehicle registration for the company vehicle and showing proof of current residence in Fryeburg.
- 3. Transfer station stickers must be permanently affixed to the inside of the windshield on the lower driver's side of the vehicle for which it was issued. Plate numbers on the sticker must match the plate number on the vehicle.
- 4. Temporary Vehicle Passes: Temporary vehicle passes are \$10.00 and the following applies:
 - a) Short-term home rentals- A Temporary Vehicle Pass, usable only on dates specified on the Pass, will be sold to the renter for \$10.00. The renter must show proof of a valid vehicle registration. The homeowner must purchase a yearly sticker prior to the issuance of a temporary vehicle pass for a renter.
 - b) A Temporary Vehicle Pass may be issued to a non-Fryeburg resident living locally upon receipt of documentation that the person is living in Fryeburg on a temporary basis due to displacement from their primary residence resulting from fire, mold remediation, etc.
 - c) Residents without a pick-up may obtain a Temporary Vehicle Pass for specified dates, for a borrowed vehicle or commercial rental vehicle (such as a Home Depot or U-Haul pick-up) as long as the vehicle is a regular pick-up with a bed of no more than 8 feet.
 - d) Contractors working on a property in Fryeburg may obtain a Temporary Vehicle Pass. The property owner must purchase a yearly sticker prior to the issuance of a temporary vehicle pass for a contractor.
- 5. Commercial haulers (i.e. Landlords, property managers, contractors, etc.) must submit an application and billing information prior to obtaining a sticker. These haulers will be billed

- monthly and failure to remit payment will result in the hauler being suspended from using the Transfer Station.
- 6. Vehicles without a sticker or a Temporary Vehicle Pass will not be allowed access to the Transfer Station. All residents unwilling to leave upon request may be reported to the Police Department and, depending on the severity, could face civil or criminal penalties.
- 7. Stickers and temporary passes are non-refundable.

It is the responsibility of each user of the Transfer Station to properly dispose of all solid waste. This responsibility includes the voluntary separation of waste. Any waste that is not separated according to the requirements of this section shall be subject to penalties.

- 1. MSW Compactor: All household refuse generated in households and commercial establishments shall be placed in this compactor. Household refuse means waste commonly generated by usual domestic activities but does not include construction and demolition debris, furniture, tv's or appliances.
- 2. Single Sort Recycling Compactor: All recyclable materials shall be placed in this compactor. Recyclable materials include rigid plastics #1-7, metal/cans, glass, cardboard, paper/newspaper. Do not bag recyclables in plastic bags.
- 3. Demolition Debris: Demolition debris generally includes shingles, drywall, plumbing parts, furniture, insulation and similar materials.
- 4. Storage areas: There are various areas designed for the disposal and storage of other waste as outlined below.
 - a. Metal
 - b. Wood Waste: Clean scrap wood.
 - c. Tires
 - d. Compost: Includes leaves, grass cuttings, pine needles.
 - e. Universal Waste: Includes TV's, computers, electronics, fluorescent lights
 - f. Paint: Most paint products are accepted in their original containers with the exception of aerosol paints and traffic/road marking paints. Paint thinners, additives, roof patch, deck cleaners are not accepted.
 - g. Brush: Brush may not consist of stumps or logs over 12 inches in diameter.

Scaling is required for commercial haulers, and residents who are disposing of demo, furniture and numerous bulky items. It is required that people weigh in on the scale, then dispose of waste and proceed back across the scales. After the final scaling then people need to go to the scale house and pay for the waste disposed of. Commercial haulers will get a slip noting the cost of disposal and will be billed accordingly.

Waster generated outside of the boundaries of Fryeburg shall not be disposed of at the Fryeburg Transfer Station.

Fees for disposal and penalties are set by the Select Board. The Town has video surveillance in use on the premises to aid in the prosecution of crimes; including illegal dumping, trespassing and theft from the Town of Fryeburg Transfer Station.
