This permit, if issued pursuant to the applicant’s representation of driveway entrance design and location, is subject to change, suspension or revocation if additional information should disclose that the information provided hereto is incorrect or inaccurate. This permit is issued based upon the information provided by the applicant. The conclusion of the Road Commissioner is that the Town of Fryeburg Driveway Entrance Ordinance has been compiled with, but does not necessarily represent all permits and approvals which may be required such as Department of Environmental Protection, Fryeburg Land Use Authorization, building/plumbing permits, or private approvals or permissions such as from subdivision lot owners associations, which shall be the responsibility of applicant to procure. Failure to procure and abide by all required municipal and state permits shall be grounds for suspensions or revocation of this permit. In accepting the issuance of this permit, applicants and applicant’s agents agree that the Road Commissioner, Public Works Director, Code Enforcement Officer and other municipal officials may enter the property during construction of the driveway entrance, and upon completion of construction at all reasonable hours, without requirement of advance notice or permission, for purposes of inspecting to ensure compliance with the terms of this permit and the Town of Fryeburg Driveway Entrance Ordinance.

Conditions of Approval:

- The Driveway Entrance Permit is effective for two (2) years from the date of approval. If the driveway entrance had not been completed within that permit period, the permit is deemed expired and a new application must submitted and approved.
- Driveway Entrance Inspection: The applicant shall notify the Road Commissioner within five (5) business days from the completion of construction or alteration of the driveway entrance. The Road Commissioner shall conduct an inspection of the driveway entrance to ensure full compliance with all provisions of this ordinance and terms of this permit.
- Building Permits. The Code Enforcement Officer shall not issue building or other development permits until a driveway entrance permit is obtained.
